

## 12-The sequencer's top bar - Zooming

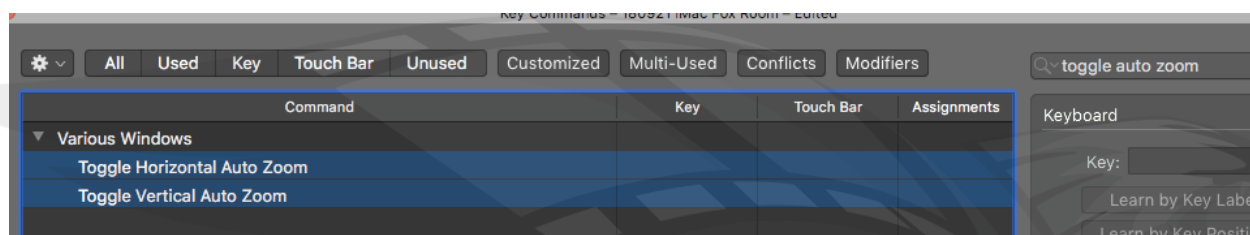
The Waveform Zoom Button will increase or decrease the height of the waveform of an audio region, just for display purposes. It will not change the amplitude or volume of the sound.

The Vertical Auto Zoom button will adjust the vertical zoom of the tracks in order to see all the tracks at the same time without the need of scrolling up or down.

Notice how this zoom function has nothing to do with the track zoom inside the Tool Bar [View > Show Toolbar](#). This other zoom function will just zoom one track, the one selected.

The Horizontal Auto Zoom button will work in a similar way to the Vertical Auto Zoom button. It will zoom in a such a way that the entire regions are in view at the same time.

Setting a key command for the Vertical and Horizontal Auto zoom is a great idea. Do this by searching “Toggle Auto Zoom” in the key-commands window and you will see both appear.



The next two sliders are the common vertical and horizontal zooms, usually activated with key-commands.
