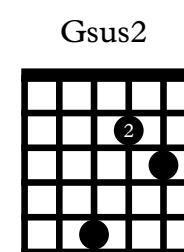
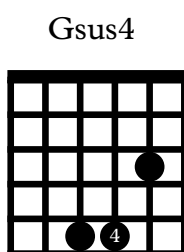
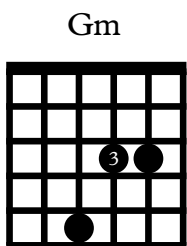
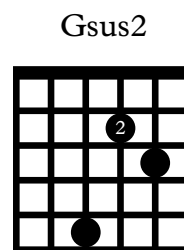
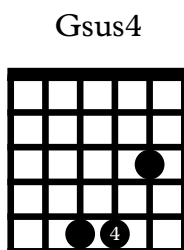
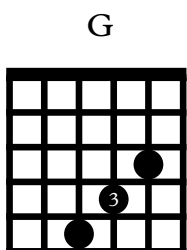
How to find Sus 2 & 4

We have been looking a lot into the use of substitute tones in our chords but, how do we find them?

In major chords, we can find the 4th substitute tone one step above from the 3rd and the 2nd substitute tone 2 steps below the 3rd.

In minor chords, it is the opposite movement!

The 4th substitute tone is 2 steps up from the b3rd, and the 2nd substitute tone is one step below the b3rd.
